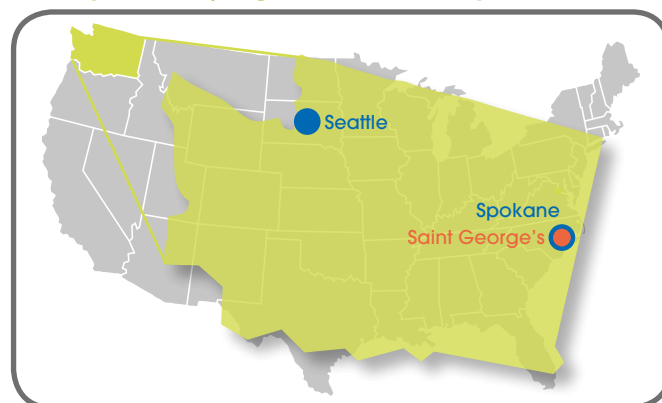
School Profile
