

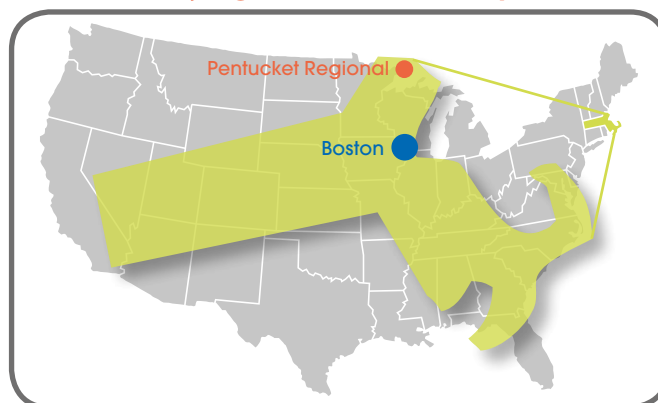
Public High School
