Academics:

The Bournemouth Collegiate School teaches a broad and balanced curriculum; they currently offer 21 subjects at GCSE and 20 subjects in the sixth form for AS and A2. Students benefit enormously from small class sizes and individual attention from the team of dedicated and enthusiastic teachers. In addition to the wide range of AS and A2 levels and a varied extra curricular programme, the Sixth Form students will have the chance to learn certain life skills which may prove invaluable when eventually taking up a university place.



Extra Curricular:

Students will be able to join in with a very wide range of activities at lunch times and after school—including sports, musical opportunities (orchestras, playing in a band, choir etc.), public speaking, cookery classes, Duke of Edinburgh award, Film clubs, Art and Homework clubs to name but a few. Music and drama are also particularly important to the life of the school and your child will be encouraged to take part in a wide range of drama productions and music ensembles.

Boarding at Bournemouth Collegiate:

Years 7 and 8 share comfortable and airy bedrooms, which accommodate up to 4 beds in order to encourage mixing and the formation of friendship groups. Years 9 and 10 share double study bedrooms whilst Year 11 enjoy the privacy of single room. Years 12 and 13 also enjoy single study bedrooms and the atmosphere is more like a university hall of residence as they enjoy greater freedom and flexibility of mealtimes.
