St Teresa's School is an all girls Catholic school with over 500 girls aged 11 to 18, including over 90 boarders. The School was founded in 1928 in the Manor House, which dates back to 1799 and is built on the site of a manor house mentioned in the Domesday Book.

The school is situated in 48 acres of outstanding natural beauty in the Surrey hills- ensuring a wonderful environment for the girls to live and study in. St Teresa's is a school with a 'can do' ethos which provides the level of support and care necessary to stimulate, and ensure that each girl achieves to her maximum and can shine in her chosen area.

Academic Approach:

The curriculum is broad and challenging and extends well beyond the bounds of the National Curriculum so that young minds are stimulated and intellectual curiosity fired in all areas of learning - not just the narrowly academic.

In the important public examination years, girls still have access to a broad programme of study taught by enthusiastic staff with access to excellent facilities. Hard work, first rate tuition and the right level of support for each girl ensure exam results of which the school and the girls can be justifiably proud!



The Boarding Experience:

St Teresa's offers first class boarding facilities with around a third of the girls at St Teresa's choosing to board on a weekly or termly basis. Younger girls are accommodated in bright attractive rooms sharing perhaps with up to 5 other girls, while older girls have their own study bedrooms.

Each year has its own Common Room with television and video recorder. There is a newly equipped games room with digital television, a pool table and table tennis table. A programme of activities and trips are arranged for boarders for evenings and weekends.

Music and Sport:

The school has an excellent reputation in music and all pupils are encouraged to learn at least one instrument. Choirs, ensembles and individuals are entered for competitions and festivals and there is a thriving school choir and orchestra who perform concerts during the school year. Sports facilities at the school are excellent and in line with the level of education and coaching available.
