Academics at Henley College:

Henley is proud of the wide range of courses that it offers. There is considerable flexibility and choice in The HENLEY College curriculum - an extensive subject choice of AS/A Levels, the International Baccalaureate and Diplomas at various levels to suit all needs.

A Level Programmes- Most students choose four (or, exceptionally, five) subjects to broaden their programme in their first year. In the second year, many students will probably study three or four A Levels (A2).
