
Queen Elizabeth's Community College - Devon, UK

Academics:

The school aims to provide all students with a balanced and broadly based Sixth Form course.



Location: Crediton, Devon

Crediton is a market town of approximately 6500 people which lies in the heart of an area of outstanding natural beauty and only 8 miles north-west of Exeter. The area enjoys good schools, good shops, low crime rate, sustained employment prospects and a very active community spirit; all set in this wonderfully attractive part of Devon. The area claims to produce some of the best food in Europe. The local farms produce high quality meat and game. Local cheeses, home grown beef and organic vegetables are found in the high street shops and farmers' market. Around Crediton there are several dairies and creameries, which are open to the public. There is a Farmers' Market on the first Saturday of each month.
