St Andrews is the Irish centre for the Model United Nations and is the host school for MUN each year in Ireland.

About St. Andrew's College

The college is situated in the southern suburbs of the city in an area of scenic parkland, less than 15 minutes by bus/rapid rail from the city centre.

The college consists of a modern building incorporating classrooms, specialist teaching rooms, offices, cafeteria, library, resource rooms, gymnasium, a separate senior secondary block, computer/IT rooms and staff offices. Most recently the College added a 6th Form Centre. A modern canteen offers a lunch menu each day.

Subjects Offered

Sports

Sport is a major feature of life in St. Andrews - it is one of the leading rugby schools of Ireland. Other sports include athletics, badminton, basketball, cricket, golf, gymnastics, hockey, sailing, football, swimming, tennis and volleyball.

The College has recently added extensive multi-purpose all-weather, floodlit sports grounds. The College also offers an extensive range of extra-curricular options – from the College Magazine (The Grapevine) to chess, music, golf, etc
